Maryland Department of Health's Behavioral Health Administration and presenters from Lower Shore Clinic, Inc. are hosting a webinar on increasing access and uptake of COVID-19 vaccines for service recipients within the public behavioral health system (PBHS). Attendees will learn:

- how to increase rates through utilizing existing infrastructures
- intervention protocols, and
- leveraging community partnerships and integrated primary cares.

Based on claims paid through 11/21/2021, data show higher vaccination rates among providers of Lower Shore Clinic, Inc. and Go Getters, Inc. Approximately 71% of individuals aged 12 years and older have received at least one dose of the vaccines, and 65% of them have completed the primary series.
