RE: Waiver of Certain Enrollment Requirements for Registered Behavior Technicians

NOTE: **Please ensure that appropriate staff members in your organization are informed of the contents of this transmittal.**

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Effective immediately, the Department is waiving the requirement for behavior technicians (BTs) to be registered with the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB) through the end of CY 2022. BTs must meet all other Medicaid enrollment requirements in accordance with COMAR 10.09.28.02I. This action will permit BTs to provide ABA therapy services to eligible participants, while obtaining the training and experience necessary for RBT certification. All BTs are required to submit proof of RBT certification to the Program for continued Medicaid enrollment by January 1, 2023.

All BTs rendering ABA services to Medicaid participants must enroll with Medicaid via the electronic Provider Revalidation and Enrollment Portal (ePREP). The following instructions apply to BTs submitting applications in ePREP:

1. Select the specialty code 318 for RBTs.
2. Enter "RBT Pending" for the license number.
3. Enter the application date for the issuance date.
4. Enter December 31, 2022 as the expiration date.
