Mental Health, Substance Use Disorder, and Poison Diagnosis Lists

November 10, 2022

Target Audience: All Behavioral Health Providers

Medicaid has updated the ICD 10 Covered Diagnosis Codes lists for behavioral health services in accordance with COMAR 10.67.08.02. We have revised the list to include the termination date and or effective date of deleted and newly covered codes. Please review your claims practices and update as necessary.

The [Mental Health Diagnosis list](#) has been updated to include:

- F43.81 - Prolonged grief disorder
- F43.89 - Other reactions to severe stress

The following code was terminated on September 30, 2022:

- F438 - Other reactions to severe stress

The [Substance Use Disorder list](#) has been updated to include:

- F10.90 - Alcohol use, unspecified, uncomplicated
- F10.91 - Alcohol use, unspecified, in remission
- F11.91 - Opioid use, unspecified, in remission
- F12.91 - Cannabis use, unspecified, in remission
- F13.91 - Sedative, hypnotic or anxiolytic use, unspecified, in remission
- F14.91 - Cocaine use, unspecified, in remission
- F15.91 - Other stimulant use, unspecified, in remission
- F16.91 - Hallucinogen use, unspecified, in remission
- F18.91 - Inhalant use, unspecified, in remission
- F19.91 - Other psychoactive substance use, unspecified, in remission

The [Poison diagnosis list](#) was updated to include:

- T43652A - Poisoning by methamphetamines intentional self-harm, initial encounter

These diagnosis codes are effective October 1, 2022. Optum Maryland is reprocessing claims for dates of service that were denied for these codes, since this date. These

claims are expected to appear on the PRA no later than the week of November 20, 2022.
